

Entries close at **1.00pm** on the Wednesday before each show and times can be found on the website: www.bodiaminternationalarena.com from Thursday evening.

Entries can either be made via email at bodiamdressage@gmail.com, and payment via PayPal (also bodiamdressage@gmail.com); or via post with cash enclosed to C Redford, 9 Harold Terrace, Battle, East Sussex; TN33 0BP

Riders will be awarded points throughout the 6 qualifying shows on a sliding scale basis. 1st place = 10 points / 10th place = 1 point. There will be a separate leader board in each category (Walk Trot – Elementary): An ongoing leader board can be viewed at: www.bodiaminternationalarena.com.

There will be high point rosettes (1st-3rd) and a 1st prize in each category for the horse/rider combinations who have accrued the most points over the 6 qualifying shows. These will be presented at the final show.

Please note that in the event of equality of total marks, the collective marks will be added together and the horse with the higher collective marks will take the higher placing.

Eligibility:

- Walk/Trot is open to any horse/rider combination who has not won at Prelim or above.
- Prelim is open to any horse/rider combination who has not won at Novice or above.
- Winning at a higher level will exclude you from the Series Championship of any lower level in which you have previously competed (excluding Elementary).
- If you win the Bodiam Walk/Trot or Championship Prelim class 3 times within the current series, with a score of 70% or above, we would ask that you move on to the next level to encourage a competitive environment. In this case you will automatically gain qualification to the Championship at the level you have moved from, unless you then win the level above.

Covid Rules:

- By entering the event you agree to comply with the rules set out below. Failure to do so will result in automatic elimination and you will be asked to leave the premises.
- Please observe social distancing rules and wear masks in the mezzanine.
- Please only bring one helper per horse/rider combination.
- Toilets will **NOT** be available.
- The Café will not be open for the time being.
- Test Sheets will be available to collect as soon as they are scored from in the mezzanine. Masks **MUST** be worn when entering the mezzanine. Results will be posted online by the end of the day, and rosettes can either be collected at the next show, or posted with an SAE. Please leave an SAE on the day if you would like them posted.
- We politely ask that as soon as you have ridden your tests you leave the venue to ensure maximum social distancing and space in the car parks. Please park considerately and allow at least 3m between horseboxes. Trailers are to park in the top outdoor school - this will be clearly signposted.
- There will be a one way system in place which must be adhered to. Maps have been attached below to display this.
- The indoor warm up is limited to the next three riders to go. This is down to the discretion of the steward who will be on the gate supervising this.
- Bridle or numnah numbers **MUST** be worn.





SHOW RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All classes are run under British Dressage rules and Competitors agree to be bound by them. The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor having in such a manner as to constitute a breach of these rules.
- Equine Passports must be presented to the office on arrival, before unloading your horse.
- The organisers and owners of the event centre accept no liability whatsoever, or howsoever caused or any damage, loss or injury to any persons or property whilst on the premises.
- Please be safe and be aware of others and your surroundings. Please pick up your litter and horse droppings before you go.
- All competitors/riders must wear correct riding attire and a riding hat at all times on the showground, to current BSI safety standards.
- The decision of the judge is final.
- All horses must be at least 4 years of age and it is the owner's responsibility to ensure that their horse is fully vaccinated.
- No refund of money entries will be made unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced.
- The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event/alter the order of the classes if there are insufficient entries.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at **ALL** times.

Objections must be lodged with the show secretary in writing with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the incident in question. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

By entering the Show you are consenting to ourselves, catering company, videographers and photographers contacting you by electronic means. If you do not consent, please advise the secretary when submitting your show entry.
